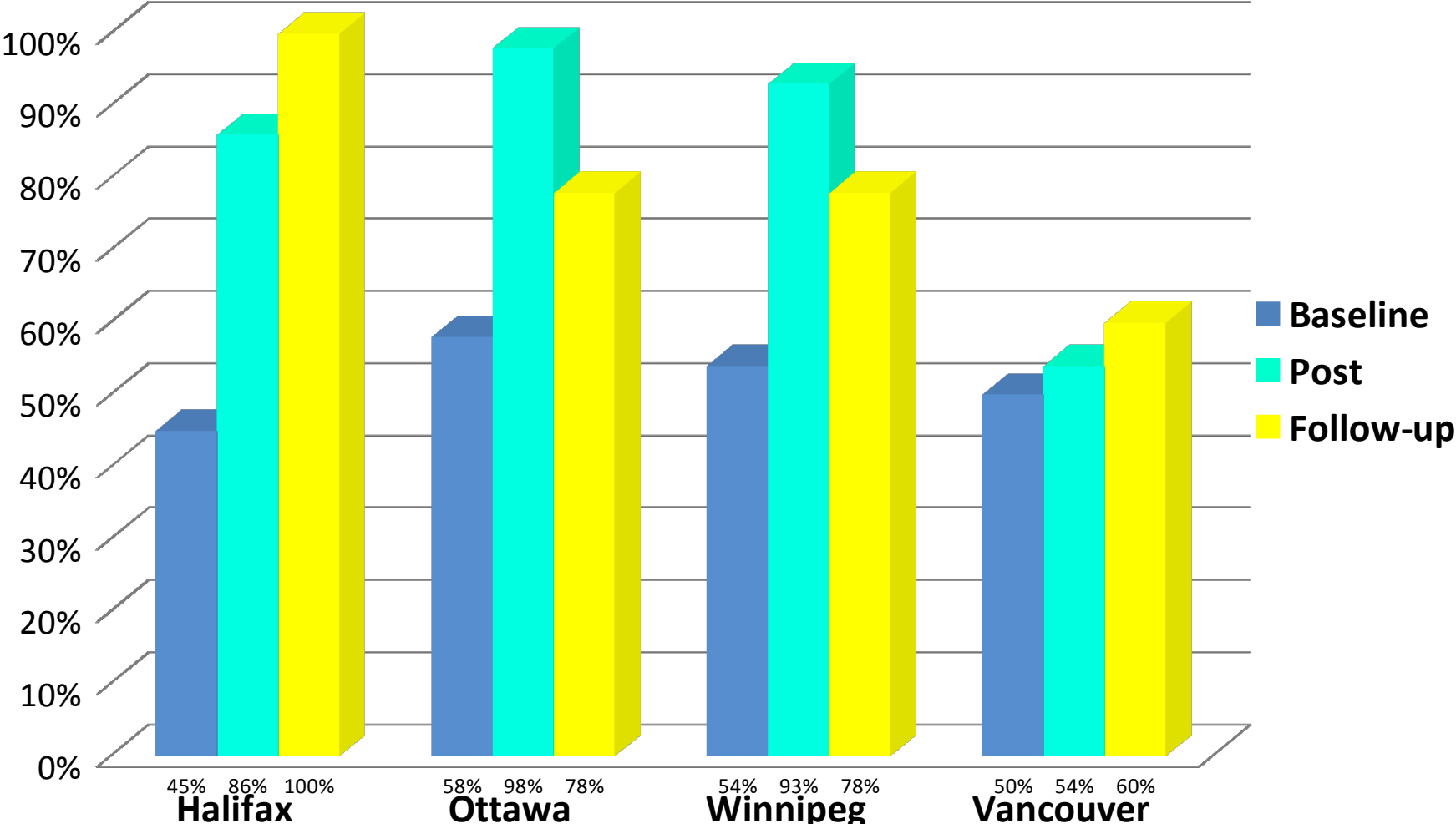
# Knowledge of SGBA



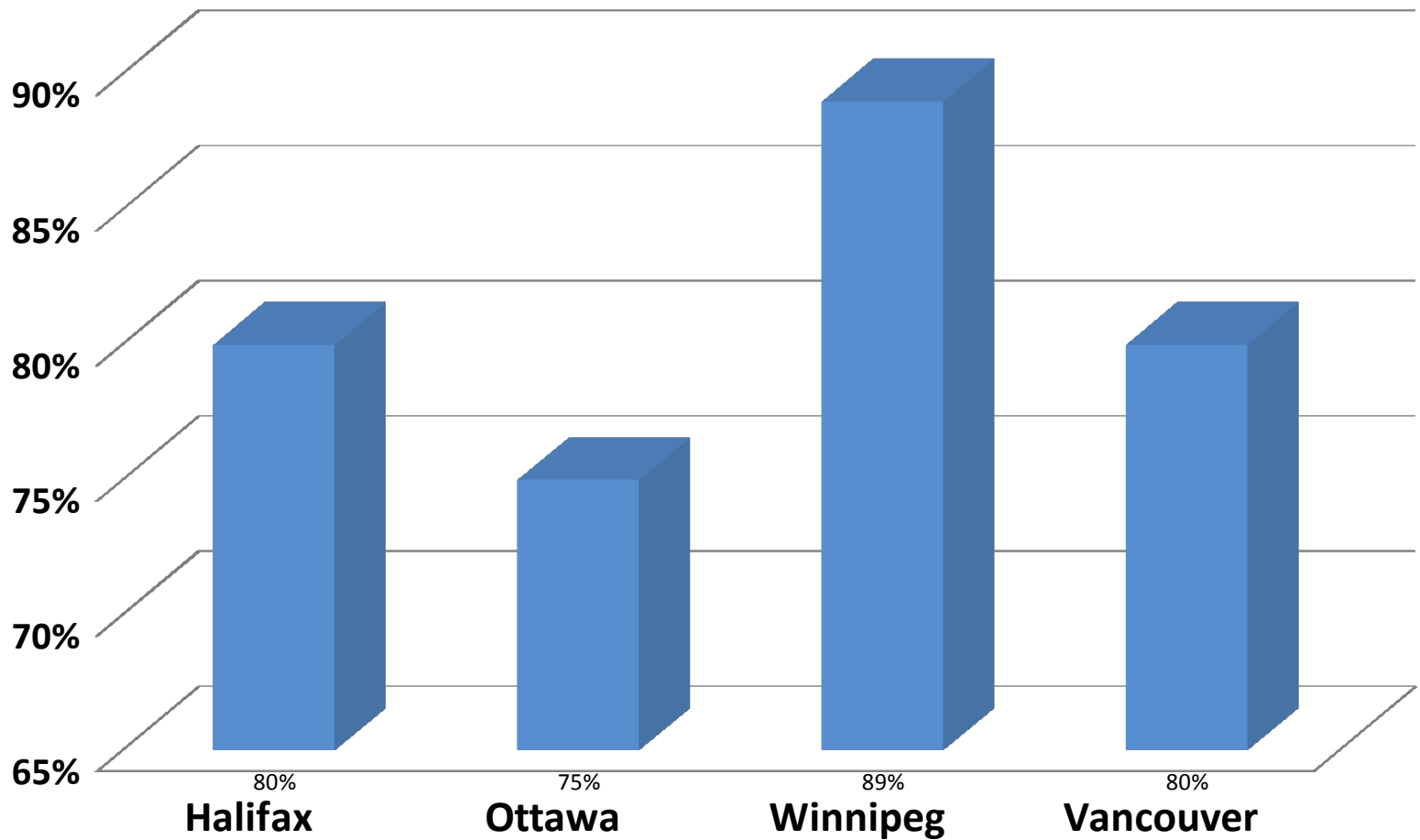

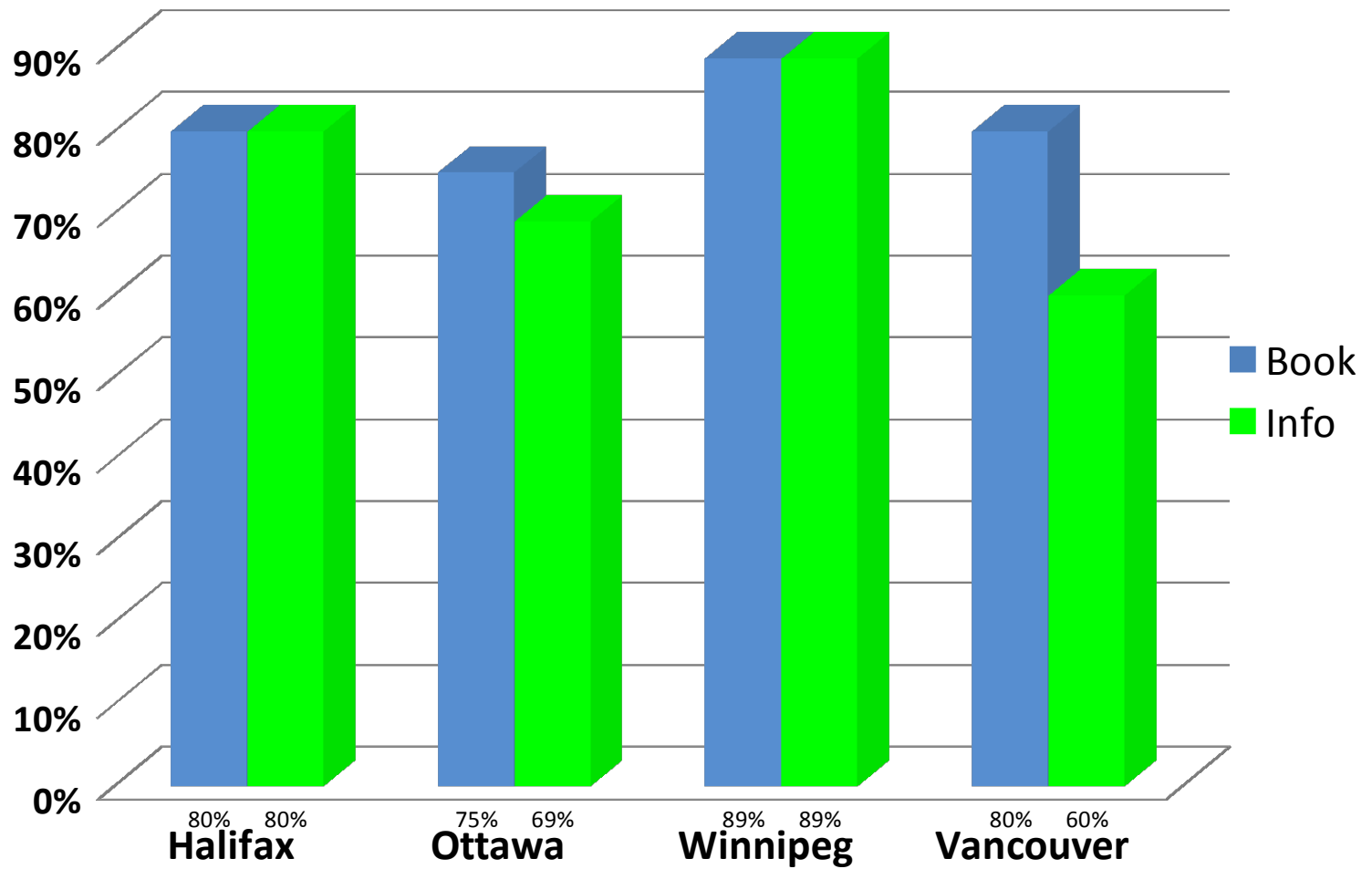
