

Complexity of the legal system

- Child support matters in the Federal Magistrates Court
- Property and children's matters in the Family Court if the matter is complex
- Family violence intervention/protection orders in the [State]Magistrates' Court, and
- Child protection issues in the Children's Court.
 (Women's Legal Service Victoria 2009)

Criminal matters, e.g. breach of FVIO or assault in the County Court

- Breaches of parenting plans such as location orders, e.g. when child is not returned, and
- Victims of Crime Assistance Tribunal


