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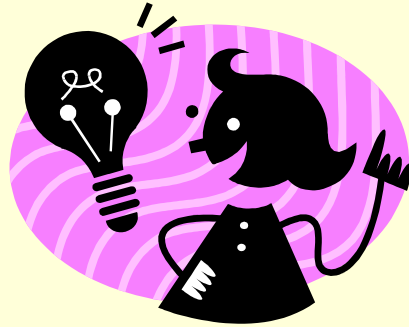

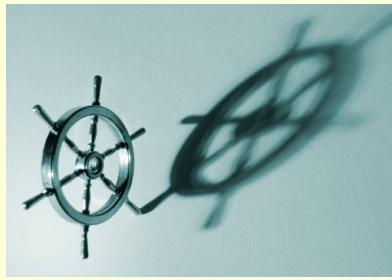

April 27th 2012 the first Implanon NXT insertion and removal training was held at PAC. 14 nurses/midwives attended, 6 from PAC.

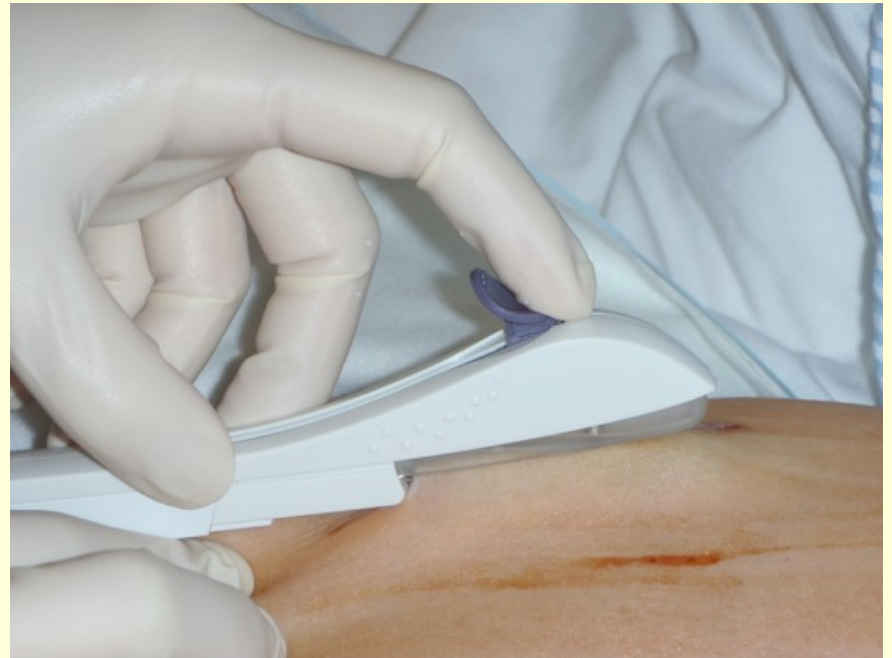
- To date PAC nurses have inserted 160 Implanon NXT's.
