A qualitative analysis of contraceptive use and barriers to access among Australian women

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- We know that contraceptive use and preferred methods change over time.
- A comprehensive life course perspective is lacking.
- What do adult women say about their contraceptive use throughout their reproductive lives?





- Funded by Australian Government to inform women's health policy
- 40,000 women selected from Medicare database
- Postal self-report surveys completed every 3 years since 1996 by 3 age cohorts
- Recruiting new cohort of 18-23 year olds in 2013




